A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS APPROVING THE MANHOLE REHABILITATION CONTRACT WITH FUQUAY, INC. FROM THE BUYBOARD PURCHASING COOPERATIVE IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$98,595.00; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, as part of its overall sewer maintenance plan City staff has identified eleven manholes in need of rehabilitation; and

WHEREAS, three of the manholes have inflow infiltration that will be repaired as part of the project; and

WHEREAS, the City has previously used Fuquay, under the same Buyboard contract, to successfully perform sewer replacement through pipe-bursting; and

WHEREAS, Fuquay proposes that they can accomplish the construction at a price not to exceed \$88,595.00.00, plus a contingency of \$10,000.00 for any needed structural improvements that may be identified as the project progresses.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the Seguin, Texas:

SECTION 1. The BuyBoard manhole rehabilitation contract with Fuquay, Inc. in an amount \$98,595.00, including contingency, is hereby approved.

SECTION 2. The City Manager, Steve Parker, is authorized execute the attached proposal with Fuguay, Inc.

SECTION 3. This resolution is effective on and after the date of its passing.
