Re: Interlocal Agreement with Guadalupe County

Guadalupe County is requesting a renewal of the interlocal agreement with the Seguin Fire Department to provide fire protection service to residents living in unincorporated areas of the county. The contract also provides for backup fire protection to the volunteer fire departments serving these areas. The current contract amount is \$350,000. For the FY22 budget, the county has approved a contract amount of \$400,000 to provide fire protection to the entire county. The City of Seguin will receive a net annual sum of \$323,000 for services rendered which is an increase of \$39,906, or 13% increase over our current year. The City of Seguin subcontracts a portion of these services to Cibolo and Schertz and they receive the balance of \$77,000 from the city. The term of this agreement will for one year, ending September 30, 2022.
