Subject: Engineering Services Walnut Branch Sanitary Sewer Main
Phase IV

In October 2020, City Council approved an agreement with RPS for engineering services for the Walnut Branch Sanitary Sewer Main Phase IV project. At that time, the scope included 30% design of the sewer main, opinion of probable construction cost, project implementation schedule, and technical memorandum.

Staff is now ready to proceed to 100% design and construction. The project will consist of the installation of approximately 1,810 linear feet of 30" sanitary sewer gravity main along Walnut Branch, beginning approximately 250 feet north of Court Street and ending approximately 600 feet south of Nolte Street. RPS's scope of work includes 100% design of the sewer main, bid process, construction oversight and sub-surface and geo-technical engineering.

Staff is requesting approval of a professional services agreement with RPS for the Walnut Branch Sanitary Sewer Main Phase IV project in the amount of \$279,876.00.

Funding is provided by utility fund capital projects and 2018 utility revenue bonds. Staff recommends approval and will be available to answer any questions at the November 16, 2021 City Council Meeting.
