Discussion on the FY2017/2018 Budget - Doug Faseler, City Manager and Susan Caddell, Director of Finance

City Manager Doug Faseler and Director of Finance Susan Caddell advised that there were some minor changes to the FY2018 Budget. They are as follows:

General Fund:

Reduce Indigent Health \$21,441 Increase VCLG Grant Revenue \$38,246 Decrease After School Program Revenue (Attendance is low) \$32,500 Increase Non Departmental Office Equipment Rental \$2,000 Reduce Property Tax Revenue \$25,187

Utility Fund:

Increase Non Departmental Office Equipment Rental \$2,000
Reduce Wholesale Power Costs \$2,000
Decrease Development Services Center \$295,000
Increase King Street Water Main Replacement and Upgrade \$400,000
Increase Use of Retained Earnings \$400,000

Budget Amendments for August 15, 2017 City Council Agenda Huber Road Sanitary Sewer Extension (Engineering) \$ TBD Development Services Center (Architectural Services) \$295,000

Pictures of the two Fire Stations in need of repair were shown:

Fire Station No. 3 is in need of being replaced in its entirety

Fire Station No. 2 has one wall that is failing and will need to be replaced

Doug Faseler also presented to City Council a revised two-year strategic plan which has a great number of projects that have been completed or in progress this fiscal year.
