Tomas Castelllon Jr. 410 Gordon

Thanked the Public Works Department for the hard work on picking up all the brush from the heavy rain and winds from Hurricane Harvey.

Also, spoke about the building at 108 West Mountain. The total cost has not been published in the newspaper as he had requested. Members of council represent the peope/taxpayers and they need to be aware of the money that is being spent to renovate buildings when you could build from the ground up.

Would like to still represent the City by volunteering his time on a board and/or committee.

Tim Barr 103 East Mountain

Spoke to City Council about his editorial that was published in Sunday's paper. There is a confederate monument in Central Park named "Home Town of Texas Confederate Colonel John Ireland". Erected by the State of Texas in 1964 and is inscribed as a memorial to Texans who served the Confederacy. Let's call this monument for what it is: a relic of white supremacy from 1964. We need to re-examine the kinds of heritage that merit public celebration. Mr. Barr would ask City Council to create a conversation to remove the monument.

Julian Leal 849 Prexy

Mr. Leal said that Mr. Castellon brings up good points about the Mountain Street property. We cannot build up these buildings at the enormous amount of money it costs.

Council Member Ernest Leal - would like to have a Neighborhood meeting at the new Utility Operation Center. Mr. Faseler stated that at this time the City is preparing for a Grand Opening and after that date we will schedule a neighborhood meeting in District 1

Also, what about Austin St - Michael Sharp, Engineer Associate, stated that TxDOT realizes that the one-way traffic is not going to work and disrupting for the residences and businesses. TxDOT is looking for ways to get the project back on schedule, wanting to be more proactive. Michael Sharp said he would ask TxDOT to provide the City Council a progress report at a future meeting.

Council Member Chris Rangel - Neighborhood Clean Up, wanted to thank Jack Jones and his crews as well as the students of Texas Lutheran University for a great job.

City Manager advised that there will be a FEMA meeting with City and County on Friday, September 22, 2017.

The Tub Grinder will be here in early October to begin mulching. TCEQ had approved of the Temporary Debris Site and has notified the City that the approval remains effective until October 20, 2017.

Jack Jones said that the Central Park fountain will probably not be back in service until early December.
