The City Council met in a REGULAR Called Meeting on Tuesday, February 18, 2020 at 5:30 pm in the City Hall Council Chambers, City Hall, 210 East Gonzales in City of Seguin, with Mayor Don Keil presiding.

Mr. Huff said his motivation for addressing the City Council was not exclusively personal, but includes many of those who are unable to attend due to health, family dynamics or that 5:30 pm is just too early for many people to make it home from work in time to attend.

Mr. Huff said his recitations are based on public record inquiries related to Ordinance #1245 and the subsequent Annexation Service Plan. Mr. Huff spoke on the lack of adequate fire hydrants, street lights, traffic signage, overall condition of streets, drainage, and wastewater service. Mr. Huff said "on behalf of the citizens of the Caters/Parkview Subdivision we propose the City Coouncil add this item to next

council agenda. He recommends and hopes, upon an in depth, transparent investigation of the facts, that the council will conclude and immediately repeal Ordinance #1245, and voluntarily dis-annex". Otherwise the citizens of the Caters/Parkview subdivision have but the following alternates:

1. Petition the city to dis-annex by election.

2. Petition the Mayor to immediately dis-annex for "Failure to provide services".

3. Serve individual Writs of Mandamus as specified in the Local Government Code, Chapter 43.

4. Reimbursement of taxes/legal fees to those citizens affected as prescribed by law.
